Call for Submissions

As part of Samvidhan Mahotsav 2025, we invite submissions in three categories:

I. Call For Poetry

Theme: *“We, The People: Poems on Freedom, Justice, and the Everyday Republic”*

Suggested Sub-Themes:

- The constitution in everyday life
- Rights, equality & dignity
- Voices from the margins
- Justice, protest and public memory
- Diversity, unity & idea of nationhood
- Empowerment through law & education

Guidelines:

- Submit **1–2 original poems**, each up to **40 lines (Minimum 15 lines)**
- **Languages Accepted:** English
- **Format:** Word Document (.doc/.docx), 12 pt Times New Roman, 1.5 spacing
- Include a short **bio (max 80 words)** in a separate document
- **Open to:** Writers aged 16 and above from all countries
- **Submission Deadline:** 22nd November, 2025

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II. Call For Prose (Essays & Short Stories)

Theme: “*Samvidhan Aur Samaj: Narratives of Citizenship, Identity & Transformation*”

Suggested Sub-Themes:

- Constitutional values and real lived experiences
- Gender, caste, identity & rights
- Youth and constitutional imagination
- Democracy & dissent
- Stories of communities, movements & change
- The future of rights and freedoms

Guidelines:

- Submit **1 short story or personal essay: 1000–2000 words**
- Language: **English only**
- **Format:** Word Document (.doc/.docx), 12 pt Times New Roman, 1.5 spacing
- Include a short **bio (max 100 words)** in a separate document
- **Open to:** All writers, students, educators and global citizens
- **Submission Deadline:** 22nd November, 2025

III. Online Painting / Digital Art Competition

Theme: “*India Through the Lens of the Constitution*”

Suggested Sub-Themes:

- Constitution in the Everyday Life of Citizens
- Voices from the Margins: Inclusion, Identity, and Dignity
- Digital India: Rights, Data, and Democracy
- Environmental Justice and Sustainable Future

Guidelines:

- **Format:** Hand-made / Digital Art (High Resolution PDF)
- **Size:** Minimum 2000 x 2000 pixels or scanned A4 sheet

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- **Must include:** Title & 100-word Artist Note
- **Age Groups:**
 - **Group A:** Below 16 years
 - **Group B:** 16 years and above
- Include a short **bio (max 100 words)** in a separate document
- **Open to:** All students, educators and global citizens
- **Submission Deadline:** 22nd November, 2025
